- Moon of Many Storms and Winds pəd səxʔupuhigʔəd
- Moon of Changing Weather pəd ʔʔabijigʔəd
- Moon of Frogs pəd waḡwaḡwaḡus
- Moon of the Whistling Robins pəd ʔʔwáaoc
- Moon of the Camas Roots pəd čaʔəb
- Salmonberry Moon pəd təḡʔd
- Blackberry Moon pəd ḡədbiḡʔ
- Salal Berry Moon pəd ʔaḡa
- Silver Salmon Moon pəd kʔəxʔic
- Challenging Calls of Deer and Elk Moon pəd xʔičib
- Dog Salmon Moon pəd ʔxʔáyʔ
- Sheath the Paddles Moon pəd səxʔ šicəlwaʔs
